## What is a legacy?

It can be a bequest in your will that leaves money or other valuables to the charity.

After you have left provision for family and friends it could be a fixed sum, a percentage of your estate or a particular item, for example, a piece of artwork.

## How do I do it?

To ensure that your wishes are carried out your beguest needs to be included in your will. A solicitor can advise and assist you in making the appropriate legal arrangements. You can find solicitors in your area who specialise in Wills, probate law and tax law on the Law Society website (www.lawsociety.org.uk). Alternatively, you can call the Society on 020 7242 **1222.** For some individuals there are tax advantages in making a bequest to a charity.
